Eagle Flying offers a special healing environment for boys and young men ages 12-17. Eagle Flying is a continuous entry program and accepts ongoing applications for its 5 beds.

At Eagle Flying, Youth experience culturally respectful counseling, traditional healing ceremonies, life skill training, and individualized educational opportunities in a nurturing “home” environment. Youth have the opportunity to attend NDNS4Wellness Recovery school, actively participate in developing individualized treatment plans, attend individual counseling sessions, group counseling, traditional ceremonies, Indian studies education, have access to traditional practitioners, create Native art & craft products, garden, as well as participating in other specialized activities.

As with all AIPC treatment homes, Eagle Flying Residential Treatment Home complies with all required AZ Dept of Health policies & procedures for residential care, including site licensure, staff certification/training & fingerprint clearance etc.

Criteria for enrollment is:

- Youth WANT to participate in this program and be willing to follow the program rules,
- Youth agree to and are referred and authorized for a minimum of 60 days with 90 days being an average course of treatment at Eagle Flying.
- Youth have substance abuse and/or mental health related issues that qualify them for authorization in a Level 2 treatment home environment.
- Youth have authorizations and permissions for attendance.
- Youth are medically cleared for attendance.
- Youth are not actively violent or intent on self harm.
